There was one amazing blessing through that very challenging night for all though.

The family was having a Bible study and at a quiet part Georgina, our teacher, had a chance to talk with her uncle. "Do you know who I am". "Yes of course I know you, you are Georgina." "Dadi do you know Christ?" "Yes, Gina I know Jesus." "No, dadi. Do you know Jesus truly? Have you put your faith and trust in him for salvation?" And she had the chance to witness fully to him.

Dadi was quiet for a short time and answered with a calm peace, "Yes, Gina. I know Jesus. I trust in Jesus." Shortly afterwards while they were praying together Gina couldn't make out all that he was praying, but heard the last word he spoke, "Lord", before he sighed and peacefully passed away. He knew his Lord was waiting with open arms.
